

## Does your partner:

- Show anger or impatience when your child cries or has a tantrum?
- Call your child bad names or put him down?
- Think it's funny to scare your child?
- Stop you from bringing your child to his family events?
- Make all the decisions for you and your child?
- Pretend that when he hurts your child that you are to blame or that it's no big deal?
- Tell you that your child is a nuisance?
- Get angry when you spend time with your child?

If you answered "yes" to even one of these questions, your child may be at risk.
